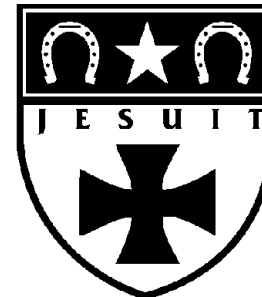

GENERAL INFORMATION & REGULATIONS

Summer School will be offered at Strake Jesuit for students who need to obtain credit for a particular course or for those students who would like to improve their understanding of a subject and thereby try to raise their grade point average. Strake Jesuit students will be allowed only into courses they took during the recently completed school year. Summer School begins Monday, June 9, and ends on Thursday, July 3, with classes held Monday through Friday. Each class period will last 2 hours and 30 minutes. Note: This schedule is subject to change. The final schedule will be set on Monday, June 9.

Late Registration

For students unable to register during the regular registration schedule above, late registration will be held on Monday, June 9, in the Library at 8:00 a.m.

All non-Jesuit students must have written permission from their school in order to attend Strake Jesuit's summer school.

Tuition

All tuition must be paid at registration with checks made payable to Strake Jesuit College Preparatory. Tuition is \$400 per course. If any course is canceled, all fees are refundable. Withdrawals from summer school during the first week will receive a 50 percent refund. Withdrawals after the first week and disciplinary withdrawals will receive no refund.

Grades

The Strake Jesuit grading scale is as follows:

Progress Reports

Parents will receive a weekly Progress Report. Note that the grade reported each week will be a *cumulative grade for the entire course*, not a grade for just that week. Also, be aware of the number of absences that the student has accumulated. Credit cannot be awarded for a course for which a student has been absent more than two times.

Dress Code

The Summer School dress code for male students is the same as during the regular school year. All male students are expected to wear a shirt with a collar, regular slacks (no jeans or cargo pants), a belt on pants made to be worn with a belt, socks, and regular shoes (no athletic shoes or the like). Shirts must be tucked in at all times while on campus. Students must be clean shaven.

Girls are to dress in their school uniform. They must bring a copy of the dress code from their school with them to registration. Girls may not wear jeans, but may wear capri pants made of traditional fabric.

All shoes must have a back. There are to be no slides or flip flops. The Summer School Principal will be the final judge.

Students who do not comply with the dress code may be asked to leave for the day.

Absences

Any student who has more than two (2) absences from class is subject to receive an F in the course and must withdraw with no refund.

Tardy

Should a student be late for a class two times, it will count as one full days absence.

Parking

Students may park only in the spaces of the main parking lot. Students are not allowed to park in faculty or visitors parking spots.

All the policies and regulations of Strake Jesuit College Preparatory are in effect during summer school. Additionally, if a student is asked to leave for the day, that student will be marked absent from class. A student may be asked to withdraw from summer school due to disciplinary reasons.
